





### Register to Vote

It takes less than 5 minutes! Use the <u>Register to Vote</u> tool to quickly and easily register or update your information. You can still vote if you do not register in advance. See the Elections Ontario website for more details.



### Mark the Date & Consider Voting Early

The election will be held on February 27, but there are many options for voting early, including at any advance voting location in your <u>electoral district</u>, at your local <u>election</u> <u>office</u>, or <u>by mail</u>. Visit the <u>Elections Ontario website</u> to review instructions for each voting option.



### Look up Where to Vote on Election Day

You can use Election Ontario's <u>Voter Information Service</u> to find out when and where to vote. This information will also be on your voter information card, which you will receive in the mail if you are registered to vote.
