## Register to Vote

It takes less than 5 minutes! Use the [Register to Vote](#) tool to quickly and easily register or update your information. You can still vote if you do not register in advance. See the [Elections Canada](#) website for more details.



## Mark the Date & Consider Voting Early

**The election will be held on April 28**, but there are many options for voting early, including at any [Elections Canada office](#), at your [assigned polling station](#) on advance polling days, or [by mail](#). Visit the [Elections Canada](#) website to review instructions for each voting option.



## Look up Where to Vote on Election Day

You can use Elections Canada's [Voter Information Services](#) to find out when and where to vote. This information will also be on your voter information card, which you will receive in the mail if you are registered to vote.
