

Omnibus: Canadian Perspectives on Energy Development

Research commissioned by Environmental Defence

December 2025

Methodology

The survey was conducted with 2,000 Canadian adults from December 5 to 11, 2025. A random sample of panelists were invited to complete the survey from a set of partner panels based on the Cint exchange platform. These partners are typically double opt-in survey panels, blended to manage out potential skews in the data from a single source.

The margin of error for a comparable probability-based random sample of the same size is +/- 2.19%, 19 times out of 20.


The data were weighted according to census data to ensure that the sample matched Canada's population according to age, gender, educational attainment, and region. Totals may not add up to 100 due to rounding.





To what extent do you trust or distrust oil and gas companies?

4 in 10 Canadians trust oil & gas companies, while the remainder are neutral or actively distrust them. Trust levels are steady from 2024.






If you had to pick between the approaches below, which of the following do you think Canada should prioritize in its energy development?


